Durgapur Primary School

Durganagar School is located in one of the most underdeveloped parts of West Bengal. The area is inhabited by agricultural laborers, and the literacy rate is very low. The school initially had very poor infrastructure due to insufficient government funding. As a result, the dropout rate was high. To change this, Caring Hands provided a grant to renovate the educational facilities including the school building, furniture, and bathrooms. We built toilets for girls and boys and provided basic classroom furniture with the goal of creating an educational environment conducive to learning and continued attendance.

St. James Community Orphans School







Amount Donated: \$2,500 School Capacity: 83

St. James Community Orphans School is a school for poor, orphaned children in the Mfangano island community in Kenya. Many children there became orphans due to the HIV/AIDS epidemic. As the government was unable to provide sufficient resources, the community there decided to create their own community school for disadvantaged children. Caring Hands Foundation paid teachers' salaries for the school.



Free COVID-19 Treatment: Hyderabad

Caring Hands collaborated with Sri Sri Holistic Hospital in Hyderabad, India, to provide free medical treatment to COVID-19 patients during the height of the pandemic. In mid-May 2020, Sri Sri Holistic Hospital opened a 50-bed COVID-19 center to provide free medical treatment for patients with mild COVID-19 symptoms and patients in recovery that only needed supplemental oxygen. As infection rates increased, Sri Sri dedicated another 20 beds to underprivileged patients for free treatment. Hands Caring Foundation gave a grant of \$35,000 to Sri Sri Holistic Hospital to provide free treatment to underprivileged patients in the intensive care unit, many of whom needed life-saving treatment for COVID-19 and/or severe black fungal infections.

During COVID-19, the transition from in-person to virtual caused several disruptions to the workforce. Many people became homeless. To address the homelessness crisis, Caring Hands collaborated with Silicon Valley Independent Living Center to provide emergency housing assistance to families in need. In 2017, we donated \$10,000. In response to COVID-19 in 2021, we donated another \$10,000.



Lunch Bag Service

The lunch bag service program is one of the oldest and well known programs led by Caring Hands Foundation. The program first started in 2012 when Caring Hands learned about the need for packaged meals from local homeless shelters where many occupants would come to stay overnight and go out to search for work during the day. For these people, it was really important to have a packed lunch meal so they could travel efficiently. Every Saturday and Sunday throughout the year, Caring Hands makes 60 bagged meals and delivers them to local homeless shelters in Silicon Valley. Over the years, this program has grown to include over 200 Caring Hands volunteers. The meals support local homeless shelters including HomeFirst in Sunnyvale, CA.
