Light Beyond Vision

"Light Beyond Vision" provides college scholarships to visually impaired students from impoverished backgrounds with the goal of empowering them to be self-sufficient. In the past, 90% of visually impaired students would discontinue their studies. To address this disparity, we decided to help provide financial assistance. The cost of sponsoring the education of one student was Rs.2500 or \$34 dollars per month towards tuition and boarding fees. Many of the sponsors maintained regular contact with their sponsored child and provided encouragement and guidance.

In 2023-2024, we funded college education for 40 visually impaired students from Odisha, India.

Kolotan School



Caring Hands is funding the construction of new educational facilities for Kolotan School in Santoshpur, West Bengal, India. Inspired by Rabindranath Tagore's vision for education, Kolotan school provides holistic education to students, fostering a harmonious blend of academic rigor and artistic expression through music, art and dance. With the help of Caring Hands, the school will expand from teaching children in nursery-class V to nursery-class X. Each class will consist of 30 students for a total of 390 students ages 3 to 16 years old.

Odisha Association of the Blind (OAB)

OAB is a non-profit organization founded in 1975 that provides essential services including schooling and vocational training to the visually impaired in Odisha, India. CHF is renovating the residential facilities for OAB students and staff, as the facilities had fallen into severe disrepair. We plan to make it a safe, healthy, and vibrant environment for the visually impaired in Odisha to continue on their path to self-sustenance. Renovations include reconstruction of the boys and girls' hostels as well as staff quarters.

Happy Classroom

In partnership with Friends of Kolkata's Elderly, Caring Hands is assisting in the development of an after school educational program called "Happy Classroom" to improve basic literacy skills of students using the old age homes as educational centers. The educational program focuses on teaching students to develop their own aptitude and work diligently on filling their learning gaps in order to become self-reliant students. In addition, the program also allocates time for social activities such as working in groups, caring for senior citizens, and arts and crafts that will help them develop important life skills early on.

Gopalpur Bhagabatipur School



Gopalpur Bhagabatipur Sishu Sikha Kendra is a school located in the least developed deltaic region of the South 24 Paragans District of West Bengal, India. The school was initially built on insufficient funds from the government, leading to poor school infrastructure. In addition, the high rain falls (100 inches) during monsoon season cause flooding, forcing the school to be suspended frequently. Caring Hands renovated the educational facilities and provided classroom furniture.

Lunch Bag Service

The lunch bag service program is one of the oldest and well known programs led by Caring Hands Foundation. The program first started in 2012 when Caring Hands learned about the need for packaged meals from local homeless shelters where many occupants would come to stay overnight and go out to search for work during the day. For these people, it was really important to have a packed lunch meal so they could travel efficiently. Every Saturday and Sunday throughout the year, Caring Hands makes 60 bagged meals and delivers them to local homeless shelters in Silicon Valley. Over the years, this program has grown to include over 200 Caring Hands volunteers. The meals support local homeless shelters including HomeFirst in Sunnyvale, CA.
